

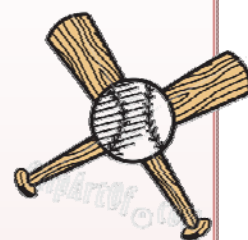

So far we have visited: Park View Primary Academy; Fountain Primary; Windmill Primary; Ebor Gardens Primary; and Beeston St Lukes.

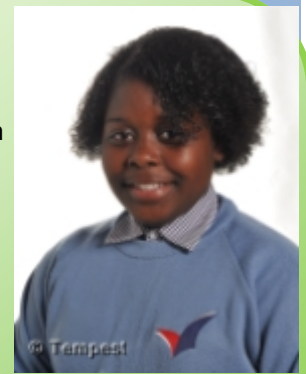
