

Travel Information

Cycle:

Access to the Leeds Core Cycle Network is provided by Route M (Middleton to City Centre) which passes to the north of the site along Armouries Way, across Black Bull Street and then continuing along Bowman Lane.

☑ A cycle lane is provided along the length of Crown Point Road, running north towards Crown Point Bridge and then continuing west along Bowman Lane.

☑ Toucan crossings are provided across Crown Point Road / Black Bull Street, Hunslet Road (at Leathley Road), and Hunslet Lane (at Crown Point Road).

There are facilities for students to secure their bikes at school – students will need to provide their own bike lock.

Train:

Leeds Rail Station is 1km (13 minutes' walk) from The Ruth Gorse Academy. The most direct walking route is north along Black Bull Street, west along Bowman Lane, through Brewery Wharf onto Dock Street, north over the river at Bridge End, west through commercial court and the up a flight of steps to New Station Street.

Buses:

The below buses come to within 400m of The Ruth Gorse Academy. Please note there are more services to Leeds City Bus Station, approximately 800m from The Ruth Gorse Academy. A half fare travel pass can be obtained from the bus station – you will need to take your child, a proof of address and proof of age (eg birth certificate/passport).
