Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to confirm arrangements for the forthcoming Eid holidays. Some of our students, staff and their families are celebrating Eid on Sunday 25 June, therefore all students will be expected to return to school on Monday 26 June 2017.

Please contact the school and ask to speak to your child's Head of Year if you have any queries about the Eid holiday.

In addition, as you may remember in December 2016 we ran a 'Christmas jumper day' for charity as one of our celebrations of faith and religion. On Monday 26 June we will hold a non-uniform day for the whole academy. We have tried to coincide this with Eid so that students, if they wish, may wear their new Eid clothes. For our students of other faiths, we are keen that they have the opportunity to celebrate their individuality and so would encourage all students to wear their own clothes of choice (appropriate to an educational setting). If you would like your child to take part in this, then we would kindly ask that students donate £1 to our students chosen charity which is One Nation. There is no expectation that students must join in and it is expected that they wear uniform as normal on this day.
